1. COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 The **aim** of the course is to form the ability to use the fundamentals of legal knowledge in the sphere of professional activity and to evaluate the solutions of the set tasks, in their area of responsibility in accordance with the planned control results. To acquire basic knowledge, abilities and skills in the main branches of Russian legislation: civil law, labour law, family law affecting the regulation of legal relations, development of legal awareness and formation of legal culture, intolerant attitude towards corruptive behaviour in students. Demonstrates an understanding of the essence of extremism and terrorism, the regulatory framework for countering extremism and terrorism.
